

CHILD CARE SERVICE

ALL children 5 and under will be placed in the day-care. There will be no exceptions.

For your convenience, free childcare services is available for children 0-5 on Saturday. Children will enjoy a variety of activities, including toys donated by **Discovery Toys**. Parents should bring a blanket, favourite toy, bottle, etc. for the younger children.

Children must be registered in advance to ensure placement. Parents do not leave the hotel if your child is in the care of our volunteers. A signed waiver is required. Parents must also pick up their children at lunch and by 4:30 pm. If you have any questions, please call AboutFace.

The \$40 per person fee includes breakfast, lunch and snack. All conference workshops and materials; child care services are provided to you at no cost. Children 12 and under are free.

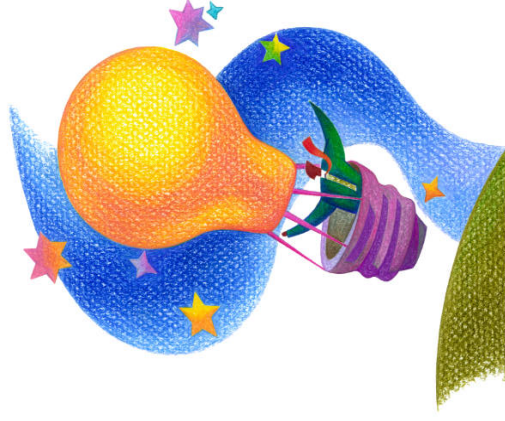

TRACKS

INSPIRATION 2006

There are 4 tracks to meet the unique needs of our different audiences.

ADULTS (for those 20 years old and older)

This track will focus on issues that affect adults with facial differences, such as meeting new people, talking about your difference and building self esteem.

PARENTS (for parents of children and teens with facial differences)

This track will address the challenges faced by parents of children and teens with facial differences, such as talking about differences, relationships and how to nurture the self esteem and confidence of their child.

TEENS (for teens ages 13—19 with a facial difference or siblings)

This track will engage teens to examine their role in developing their self esteem and empower them to become proactive members of their community and school environment.

CHILDREN (for kids ages 6-12 with a facial difference or siblings)

This track will use creative play and inter-active workshops to support and nurture the child's creativity and individuality. We will work through issues that kids identify as barriers to friendship and socialization.
